

Roman Simić was born in 1972 in Zadar, Croatia. He holds a degree in Spanish Language and Literature and Comparative Literature from the University of Zagreb. For the past six years Simić has been an editor of the "Quorum", one of the most prominent Croatian literary magazines. He is also Artistic Director for the Festival of the European Short Story and the editor of the series entitled Anthologies of European Short Story. Simić is currently working as an editor at Profil International Press.

Roman Simić edited an anthology of Croatian erotic prose entitled *Libido.hr* (Zagreb, 2002), and has prepared collections of contemporary Croatian short story and poetry for Spanish, Polish, Czech, and Slovenian literary magazines.

His short stories were included into various selections and anthologies of contemporary Croatian prose, and translated into German, Swedish, Bulgarian, Slovenian, Lithuanian, English, Czech and Polish.
