



Primož Čučnik was born in Ljubljana in 1971. He studied philosophy and cultural sociology at The Faculty of Arts in Ljubljana. Books of poetry, *Dve Zimi / Two Winters* (1999), *Ritem v rōkah / Rhythm in hands* (2002), *Akordi / Chords* (2004), collaboration book *Ode on Manhattan avenue* (2003), *Nova okna / New windows* (2005), *Sekira v medu – Selected poems* (2006) and *Delo in dom / Work and home* (2007). Selection of his poems entitled, *Zapach herbaty* (2002) was published by Zielona sowa, Krakow.

He translates mostly from contemporary Polish and American poetry, he published books of (co)translations from work of Adam Wiedemann, Marcin Świetlicki, Piotr Sommer, Eugeniusz Tkaczyszyn Dycki, Miron Białoszewski or Frank O'Hara, Elizabeth Bishop, John Ashbery. Many others were published in the Slovenian literary magazines and on the radio. He also writes literary criticism, essays, works as an editor for the magazine *Literatura* and runs a small press *Sherpa*. Lives in Ljubljana.
